Course Description

This 5-day, 40-hour program is designed to help a solo officer develop survival skills while operating in unconventional environments. It is important that the individual is trained in both hand to hand and gunfighting techniques that are applicable to the mission objectives.

The program will also address officer rescues in both structural environments and vehicles. Force on force scenarios will be used to test opportunities and techniques. This course will incorporate how to fight inside the passenger compartment of a vehicle. Fighting against edged weapons, firearms and natural weapons until rescue is complete. Students will learn how to conduct officer rescues from a vehicle, rescue team tasks and responsibilities.

Course Topics:

- Direct action combatives
- Weapon disarms
- Edge weapon survival
- Individual gunfighting scenarios under simunition
- Live fire from concealment drills
- Live fire partner drills
- HRT/crisis entry response with small teams
- Vehicle assault/vehicle hostage rescue/vehicle fighting

Day 1

- Instructor intros and schedule
- Starting with individual officer
- Understanding mission objectives and priority of life
- Blue gun work from concealment
- Introducing footwork and for both firearms and combatives in a 360 environment
- Introduction to disruptions and distance
- Introduction to weapon disarms
- Introduction to direct action combatives(Natural weapons/improvised weapons)

Day 2

- Continuation of Day 1 with more reps
- Practical force on force exercises to test reaction time and combative solutions
- Introduction to gunfighting principles under force on force scenarios (video playback analysis after each drill to help students)
- rifle team gunfighting drills under force on force (video playback analysis after each drill to help students)

Day 3

- live fire
- Individual pistol drills from concealment (instinctive shooting platforms)
- Carbine gunfighter drills to simulate rescues
- Partner drills
- Ballistic Shield live fire techniques

Day 4

- Force on Force
- Structural rescues solutions
- Small team rescues (introduction to shield)
- Low light rescues
- video playback analysis to help students)

Day 5

- Force on Force
- Officer vehicle fighting techniques and set up
- Small team rescues (introduction to shield)
- Positions for vehicle rescues and breaching possibilities/
